He has performed at Jazz at Lincoln Center: Dizzy’s Club Coca-Cola, Chicago Jazz Festival, the Kansas City Blues and Jazz Festival, and is a regular at Jazz St. Louis.

Soulful and swinging, Anita Jackson has appeared as a featured vocalist with numerous jazz, R&B, blues and gospel groups around St. Louis, leaving a lasting impact with her powerful voice and commanding stage presence. Music lovers will not want to miss this solo vocal performance by one of St. Louis’ premier ladies of song.

Tickets for each event are \$20 for a table of up to two guests, and \$40 for a table of up to four guests. Attendees have the option to pre-purchase a boxed fried chicken or vegetarian picnic dinner. Bottles of wine will also be available for pre-purchase – an on-site bar will be available the night of each concert (credit card sales only). Picnic dinners must be ordered by the Wednesday prior to each performance.
