DREW AND ELLIE HOLCOMB MAKE SHELDON DEBUT FEBRUARY 23

ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents **An Evening with Drew + Ellie Holcomb** on Wednesday, February 23, 2022 at 8 p.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall. *This event was originally rescheduled from February 26, 2021.*

Drew and Ellie Holcomb are a husband and wife Americana duo from Nashville, TN. Shortly after their marriage in 2006, the couple began touring together with Drew Holcomb & The Neighbors. The band has supported many national touring acts including The Avett Brother, NEEDTOBREATHE, Don Henley and Willie Nelson.

Ellie is no longer a touring member of “The Neighbors,” and has found solo success as a Christian singer/songwriter, winning two Dove Awards and topping the *Billboard* charts. Her most recent album, *Canyon*, was released in June of 2021. Drew Holcomb still tours nationally with Drew Holcomb & The Neighbors and their most recent album, *Dragons*, is their most critically acclaimed release yet.

An Evening with Drew and Ellie Holcomb is a special engagement event, allowing the Holcombs to collaborate once again.

Anyone aged 12 or older, attending a ticketed event at The Sheldon, will be asked to show proof of full vaccination OR a negative COVID-19 test taken no more than 48 hours before time of entry into the event. Patrons should be prepared to show their vaccination card, or proof of negative COVID test, or a photo of their vaccination card or test results on their mobile devices, before entering The Sheldon. Ticket buyers have until 11:59 p.m. the night before the event to request a refund for their tickets. The Sheldon will also maintain a flexible ticket exchange policy throughout the season to accommodate any health and safety-related concerns.
