“SHELDON CLASSICS” CONTINUES WITH CHAMBER PROJECT ST. LOUIS MAKING SERIES DEBUT

ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents **Chamber Project St. Louis: *RETOLD*** on Wednesday, April 19, 2023 at 8 p.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall.

Innovative concert experiences, inclusive programming and St. Louis-inspired musical excellence have defined Chamber Project St. Louis since its founding in 2007. Through the Project, talented musicians from across the St. Louis region join together to present chamber music of yesterday and today, engaging audiences in unique settings.

For their Sheldon series debut, the Chamber Project presents *RETOLD: Listening Forward to History*, a re-telling of America through music from the U.S. and Europe, with pieces by Cindy McTee, Joseph Haydn, Carlos Simon and Antonin Dvorak.
