**CLARINET VIRTUOSO ANAT COHEN AND QUARTET

ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents **Anat Cohen Quartet**, Saturday, January 14, 2016 at 8 p.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall. Clarinetist Anat Cohen has won audiences the world over with her expressive virtuosity and delightful stage presence. Voted Clarinetist of the Year eight years in a row by The Jazz Journalists Association, Cohen and her quartet have headlined at the Newport, Umbria, SF Jazz and North Sea jazz festivals as well as at such hallowed clubs as New York’s Village Vanguard.

Israeli-born saxophonist, clarinetist and flutist Anat Cohen is a skilled jazz musician with a bent toward sophisticated post-bop, Brazilian music, and layered, creative improvisation. An established bandleader and prolific composer, Cohen travels and performs with many groups, including with her siblings in the jazz group 3 Cohens. The Anat Cohen Quartet presents a unique blend of modern and traditional jazz, classical music, Brazilian choro, Argentine tango, and an expansive range of Afro-Cuban styles. The perennial winner of “Clarinetist of the Year” titles from *DownBeat*, *JazzTimes*, and the Jazz Journalists Association, *Fresh Air*’s Terry Gross credits Cohen with “bringing the clarinet to the world” and *The New York Times* hails her a “Master.”
