LOUIS, MO – The Sheldon Art Galleries presents a free gallery talk in conjunction with the exhibit *The Immigrants: Works by Master Photographers* (through January 12, 2019) at the Sheldon Art Galleries. Olivia Lahs-Gonzales, Sheldon Art Galleries Director, will speak on selected works in the exhibit, including the work by Dorothea Lange and Ansel Adams made in the Japanese internment camp in Manzanar, California.

Organized by the Howard Greenberg Gallery, New York, the exhibit focuses on the immigrant experience as told through the photographs of major icons from the history of photography such as Lewis Hine, Alfred Stieglitz, Margaret Bourke White, Dorothea Lange and Tseng Kwong Chi, that depict the hardship and sacrifice, pride and achievement of immigrants around the world.
